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## Team Coach

**Role purpose:** The Team Coach is responsible for the preparation and development of players, planning and delivering effective and enjoyable training sessions and leading the team on matchday.

**Duties**

- Organise training and match-day activities
- Instruct football skills and team tactics
- Plan and select the team for match-day
- Provide clear instruction and feedback to the team and individual players
- Liaise with parents/guardians as needed
- Collaborate with the Development Coach and Football Director, taking advice and direction

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- Continually seek to upgrade skills and knowledge of football
- Implement injury prevention, care and management
- Develop positive team morale and culture.

**Time commitment:**

**Term of appointment:** The Team Coach is appointed for a 1 year term.
