

History of Zeeburgia

Zeeburgia was founded in 1919 just after the end of the First World War.

The club has more than 400 members, whereas more than 3,000 supporters are playing in the football pool of Zeeburgia.

Seven senior teams and 13 youth teams are playing in the league football.

Every year Zeeburgia has a youth football tournament during Whitsun. Clubs from England, Germany and Holland are participating. Last year, Watford succeeded in winning the first prize, being the silver F.L. Verputten Challenge Cup.

Owing to the improvement of the fields, Zeeburgia cannot organise this tournament in 1965.

The 1st team of Zeeburgia is playing in the 2nd Division of the Dutch Football League. Several years before, and after, the introduction of semi-professional football, Zeeburgia was playing in the 1st Division.

The trainer, Mr. A. P. v. Ham, is a former player of our first team.

The stands are suitable for 10,000 persons.
